

When Moses prayed, Show me now Thy way, that I may know Thee, 'the Lord answered him, My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest.' And through the prophets the message was given, Thus saith the Lord, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls.
